

Bulk Buying Guide

Step 1: **Planning**

Regularly check your inventory to keep track of what you have and what is running low. Organize the storage area periodically to ensure everything is accessible and to prevent wasted items hiding in the back.

Hygiene

Always maintain cleanliness and hygiene by washing containers between uses, especially when switching contents.

Community

Consider joining or forming a bulk buying group or co-op in your community. This can help save money and reduce waste through shared purchasing and knowledge exchange.

Recycling

For items that must be purchased with packaging, ensure you recycle or repurpose the packaging materials whenever possible.
