

Feedback Exchange Mastery

Step 1: **Preparation**

Take time to process the feedback you've received. Reflect on it and make a plan for how you can address the points raised or implement the suggestions.

Step 7: **Follow-Up**

Schedule a follow-up after the initial feedback to discuss progress. It shows commitment to improvement and acknowledges the ongoing nature of personal development.

General Notes

Emotional Regulation

Manage your emotions during both giving and receiving feedback. Recognize that feedback can elicit strong reactions, but strive to remain composed and professional.

Constructive Intent

Bear in mind that the purpose of feedback is to aid growth. When giving feedback, frame it constructively, and when receiving, view it as an opportunity for improvement.

Positive Reinforcement

Balance negative feedback with positive reinforcement. Highlight strengths and achievements along with areas for improvement.
