

Narrative Podcast Editing

This playbook describes the advanced editing techniques required for creating compelling story-driven podcasts. It focuses on the use of soundscapes, pacing, and techniques to maintain listener interest throughout the podcast.

Step 1: **Script Review**

Step 7: **Mixing Tracks**

Mix the dialogue, music, sound effects, and ambient sounds, balancing the levels to ensure clarity and that no element overpowers another.

Step 8: **Review & Revise**

Listen back to the edited podcast, ideally with fresh ears, to assess the overall effect and make revisions as necessary for pacing, sound balance, and storytelling impact.

Step 9: **Finalize**

Apply final touches such as mastering the audio to the appropriate loudness standards and ensure the podcast is polished and ready for publishing.

General Notes

Story Focus

Always keep the story and narrative focus in mind when selecting music, sound effects, and ambient noises.

Listener Perspective

Regularly step back and evaluate your edits from the perspective of a first-time listener to ensure the podcast remains engaging and accessible.

Technical Quality

Maintain high technical quality in recordings to avoid distractions and reduce the need for extensive post-production editing.
